at UEA Sportspark, Norwich

#### **Meet Conditions**

- 1. The meet will take place at Norwich Sportspark on December 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> 2023 and is licensed by Swim England at Level 3 under License No. 3ER231744
- 2. The meet will be run in accordance with Swim England Regulations, Swim England Technical Rules of Swimming, and these conditions.
- 3. Competitors must be Club Compete members of an affiliated club, eligible to compete and registered in accordance with Swim England Regulations and Technical Rules and may enter in the name of one club only. Entries will only be accepted from competitors registered as members of Swim England, SASA or WASA or competitors from a country affiliated to FINA.
- 4. The promoter is Joanne Gordon on behalf of Great Yarmouth Swimming Club
- 5. The age groups for Female and Open/Male are 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15 & over
- 6. Ages are as of 3<sup>rd</sup> December 2023
- 7. Medals will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd,</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place finishes in all events in the age categories above.
- 8. The pool is [25m], anti-wave devices will be in place and AOE will be used. A secondary strobe for the starting system is available
- 9. Heats will be swum as mixed age with swimmers seeded by entry times.
- 10. Over the top starts may be used at the referee's discretion.
- 11. Cut-off times are provided and entries with No Time will be accepted.
- 12. Valid entries (which must include payment) will be accepted in the order of receipt, that is: first come first served. Complete entries for each club are required together with a single cheque or electronic payment. Individual entries will only be accepted at the Promoter's discretion. [Late entries, day of meet entries and day of meet alterations will not be accepted, unless due to administrative error.]
- 13. Those swimmers in possession of a Swim England Certificate of Swimming Disability or those swimmers whose membership details record a disability Sport Class are welcome to enter the competition.

- 14. Entry shall be by an Individual Entry Form. Where five or more competitors enter from the same club, entry shall be made using SPORTSYSTEMS Entry Manager and sending the Entry file to the Promoter. The Entry Manager software may be downloaded free of charge from the SPORTSYSTEMS website <a href="http://www.sportsys.co.uk/entry/index.php">http://www.sportsys.co.uk/entry/index.php</a>] and the required Entry File for the meet will be available on request.
- 15. If electronic entries are not being made, entry forms should be emailed to <a href="mailto:gyscevents@gmail.com">gyscevents@gmail.com</a> and a BACS payment made.
- 16. Entries together with entry fees must be received by the Promoter by October 20<sup>th</sup>, 2023.
- 17. The entry fee is £6.00 per event.
- 18. The Promoter reserves the right to limit entries and the number of heats in any event to maintain a balanced programme. In the event that entries are rejected, fees will be refunded by a single payment to club in question.
- 19. Accepted and rejected entries will be emailed to clubs within 2 weeks of the closing date.
- 20. Swimmers must withdraw from events that they no longer wish to swim. Each club will be provided with a schedule of their accepted entries. Withdrawal may be made on the day, or can be e-mailed in advance, but must be made at least 45 minutes prior to the start of the first event in each session. Refunds are not available for withdrawals after the accepted entries have been posted, other than for medical reasons.
- 21. Coaches' passes will be issued at a cost of £10 per day or £20 per day including lunch. There will be no entry to poolside without a pass and passes must be worn at all times.
- 22. Warm up protocol: Each warm up session will be divided into four equal length sessions]. There is to be strictly no diving during warm-up, with the exception of designated sprint lanes. Odd lanes will swim clockwise and even lanes will swim anti-clockwise. Swimmers must leave the water by the side of the pool and not over the timing pads.
- 23. Results will be available online at <a href="https://www.gysc.org.uk/results/WinterWipeout2023">www.gysc.org.uk/results/WinterWipeout2023</a>, emailed to clubs after the competition and will be supplied to British Swimming for entry into the national rankings database.
- 24. Sportspark have a ban on the use of cameras, camera phones and image capturing devices in the pool, deck area, spectator gallery and changing rooms. Anyone not adhering to the policy may be asked to leave by Sportspark staff.
- 25. All Participants must observe the safety precautions in operation at the Sportspark. Neither the promoter nor Great Yarmouth Swimming Club will be responsible for any loss or damage occurred during the meet.
- 26. The Data Protection Act 2018 requires us to provide you with certain information and to obtain your consent before processing data about you. Processing includes obtaining, recording, holding, disclosing, destruction or retaining information. We require certain personal data for the purposes of making entries to the competition, managing the meet and the submission of results to Rankings. The information provided by you will be processed in accordance with the Data Protection Act 2018. Consent to process such personal data is deemed to have been given by the submission of the entry. Where the personal data of competitors, officials and coaches/team managers has been passed to us by a third party such as a club rather than by the individuals themselves, we rely on the third party to ensure that consent has been obtained.
- 27. Entries will be made using Female/ Male competition categories, as these are the recognised categories at this time. You will notice a transition into the use of Female and Open/Male as the new competition categories following the launch of the Swim England Transgender and Non-binary Competition Policy on 1st September.
- 28. The Female Category is for birth sex females in accordance with Swim England's Transgender and non-Binary Competition policy. By entering the Female category, a swimmer confirms that their birth sex is female.
- 29. Any matter not covered by these conditions will be determined by the Promoter and Referee, subject to Swim England Regulations and Technical Rules of Racing.
